Discussion: Should the mentions be based on total sales or number of pieces? It was decided that top three (3) sales in two categories would be listed (2D and 3D).



Tips and Tricks - Street Shows and Garden Fairs

Street Shows and Garden Fairs

One of the best ways to find out why your art isn't selling, is to stand next to the customer and hear them comment on your work. One of the best ways to do this is to participate in a street fair and/or garden show that includes art. Here are some tips and tricks for presenting art in an outdoor venue...

Tips and Tricks to a successful outdoor show!

#1 You are not necessarily there to sell your art...you are there to get your name out there, your art seen and to understand what it is about your work the customer likes or dislikes. If you bring 50 postcards and pass all 50 of them out plus business cards with a picture of your work on it, and you pass out all of your postcards, you have had a successful show. If you have gotten their e-mail or phone number so the next time you have a new piece to announce to them, you can e-mail them your update and perhaps a photo of your latest piece....you have the beginning of an art selling business.

#2 Which show shall you participate in? Many outdoor art shows average around \$400+ for a weekend. You bring the booth and all the set up for the walls, tables, chairs etc. This can be pricey for us who do not know who our clientele is and what they may like to buy from us. SDAG participates in a variety of art shows, exhibitions and small street fairs as a way of giving you the opportunity to participate for a low price i.e. \$20-\$169 so you have the opportunity to "grow your art business" and understand what it is that customers want to buy.

#3 What if I cannot get juried into a show? SDAG participates in all kinds of shows, some juried and some not. You will have the opportunity to show your art in a variety of places throughout the year with SDAG. Just keep reading the Paint Rag for more information and how to apply. If you want to be kept in the Outdoor Art Show loop, please contact Deborrah Henry and let her know you want to be considered when we get invitations to show. Also, send her 3 images and a bio of your work so she can send them to the venue for consideration. deborrahhenry@yahoo.com

Between June 8 and July 19 the City of Encinitas will present new work by artist Juan Flores. This is Mr. Flores' first exhibit since 2008.



Some recent events that have taken place at the gallery by members have prompted this communication.

We try very hard to maintain a high level of professionalism and ethics in our business / gallery, and we expect you, the member, to honor and uphold these business ethics. We are a business that deals with the public and our integrity is highly important to our success. Compliance with the following requests is mandatory and non-compliance is cause for dismissal from membership in S.D.A.G. / Off Track Gallery.

1. Staffers, in particular, and Membership, in general, are not authorized to discuss, or express their opinions with any tenant(s) / outside business owner(s) on behalf of the Guild on management protocol of the gallery. The board has been elected by the membership, and no member should be taking it upon themselves to conduct any business for the gallery other than staffing and job positions signed up for. This includes how the guild is being run, or how they feel about what is happening at the guild due to circumstance beyond our control. Only the Board knows all the details of what is going on with the business of operating the gallery, therefore, any information imparted by other than the board is likely to be incorrect, incomplete or just plain opinion.

Maintaining a code of ethics is extremely important, and bias opinions about race, creed or color are not allowed within our guild nor to be discussed on the premises or surrounding area around the gallery.

3. We are a business that services the public, and negative comments - either personal or professional - about another artist's works while you are within the gallery are unacceptable, and absolutely never to be mentioned in front of, or communicated to, our clients. ANY negative conversations between members, either in or around our store, about the gallery and its operations, should never be made in front of clients. Any additional complaints about our artists from business owners, management or other artists communicating abuse of such ethics, is ground for dismissal of any artists from our gallery.

5. In order to maintain good relationships among all parties involved, the shopping center management company and the business owner have requested that the San Dieguito Art Guild and it's membership of the Off Track Gallery, cease any further contact / communications with Mog & Rue, next door. "Members" are no longer authorized to speak to, express their opinion to, or even "enter" the store of Mog & Rue.



SDAG Art Jurying - July 15

Hi, SDAG members!

If you are not a wall renter or floor renter at Off Track Gallery, and have not yet been juried in, you have a chance to be juried for possible renting. The next Wall and Floor Art jury will be on Friday. July 15 at floor art chairperson Linda Melvin's house, 843 Santa Regina, Solana Beach, 92075. If you plan to attend, please RSVP to Linda Melvin, 848-481-3431, <u>painter197@aol.com</u>, Drop your work off between 10:00 and 11:00 and pick it up between noon and 1:00 pm.

Bring at least four of your best pieces of artwork in each medium that you hope to exhibit as a renter. Framing and presentation are part of what the artwork is being judged on. Neatness counts. For wall art, please follow the gallery hanging rules as described in the gallery handbook. You must have been in the monthly show three times before you can rent space.

REQUIREMENTS FOR WALL RENTERS

Requirements for Wall Renters of Off Track Gallery

 Rent for a full wall space: \$90.00 of rent is due on every rotation day, which is once every two months, usually the last Thursday of every other month, so that works out to be \$45.00 of rent per month.

2. A full wall space is four feet wide from the floor to the top of the wall, but you may only use a 44 inch wide space for displaying artwork. (The gallery committee prefers, but does not require, that artists leave the bottom one or two feet of wall empty.) The guild requires that wall rent artists leave at least two inches of empty space between their artwork and the borderline between wall spaces so that your work does not get less than four inches from your neighbor's artwork. If you are on one of the little walls that zigzag, you still need to have a two inch wide border of empty space along the sides of your display space. The reason for this rule is that the gallery committee believes that a little empty space enhances the artwork and gives a higher classed appearance to the gallery.

 Security Deposit: There is a security deposit of one month's rent, \$45.00 for a full space. This is refundable if you fulfill all of our requirements- staffing, giving notice 30 days in advance, and paying rent.

4. Staffing: Currently, we expect wall renters to staff the gallery once a month for four hours. Sometimes in the summer, wall renters are required to staff twice a month for two and a half hours each session.

5. Wall rotation duty: We expect each wall renter to help at a wall rotation day once per guild year for two and a half hours. The guild year starts and ends on September 1. You do not need to climb ladders or lift things if that is difficult for you.

6. An additional job: Each renter is expected to do an additional job for the guild.

7. We require that renters sign a contract saying that they will rent for at least four months. If they resign sooner, they do not get the security deposit refunded. We need to have people rent for at least four months, which is two

rotations, in order to prevent people from renting only when it is their turn to exhibit in the front, or only at Christmas time, and also to save work for the wall rent chairperson.

8. Resigning from renting: We need to be given at least thirty days of advance notice before you resign from renting wall space. This is so that we can find a substitute renter, and so that we can find staffers to work at the times that you were going to.

Renters need to sign a hold harmless contract stating that they will not sue San Dieguito Art Guild in case their work gets damaged or stolen. Artists need to provide their own insurance if they want any to cover their artwork.

 Renters need to sign a copyright agreement which says that they will not infringe upon anyone's copyright, that their work is their own.

Benefits of renting at Off Track Gallery:

The advantage of being a renter is that you can exhibit several pieces of your artwork all together so that customers notice it and better understand what you are interested in. You have control over how it is arranged within your space. If you display a lot of artwork, it costs less per piece to exhibit if you are a renter than if you are in the monthly show. The downside, or the upside, is that you get to be more involved in the running of the gallery if you rent. If you are a past renter, consider getting back onto our waiting list.

Britta Kling (nee Schülke) was an artist whose creative, loving spirit touched everyone around her. She was born in Stuttgart, Germany and died in Leucadia, California following a two-year struggle with cancer. She is survived by husband Stanley A. Kling; sons Neal, Hannes, and Wendell Kling; and grandchildren Camille Gordon-Kling, Ben and Nate Kling, and Merle Kling-Wiese; and two brothers Ulrich and Gerhard Schülke.

Britta studied child psychology in Germany and taught Kindergarten there before emigrating to America. Here she worked early on as an au paire for families in Boston and New York City.

Britta will be remembered for her love of family, tradition and history. All people are Britta's people and she made friends easily because she celebrated all cultures and found good in everyone. Though she moved to the U.S. as a young adult, her European heritage was always present. Her father was especially dear to her, and she made sure to live up to his character and values, instilling the same in her sons.

Britta took inspiration from nature, finding beauty and wonder in the simplest of settings, as seen in her Scherenschnitte - traditional German scissor cuttings. Her works were exhibited in shows across the country. She helped establish the Offtrack Gallery at the old train station in Leucadia. She was a member of the Board of Directors of the Guild of American Papercutters, and one of her pieces was selected for the permanent collection of their National Museum in Somerset, Pennsylvania. Later, as owner of The Perfect Arrangement, a floral shop in Encinitas, she put her distinctive artisic touch on arrangements and bouquets that brought joy to many.
