Bring in Work for Take-In

- Tuesday **January 28, 2025 3:00-5:30 PM**
- Artwork must be hand delivered to the OffTrack Gallery with receipt of payment.

Entry Fees

- Fees are dependent on the diagonal size of the painting; there are three size categories. Payments are made online during the entry application process.
- Up to 2 entries per per artist.

Awards

Award winners will be notified via email.

- Best of Show: **\$50** and Ribbon
- First Place(s): Ribbon
- Second Place(s): Ribbon
- Third Place(s): Ribbon

All Award Winners will be posted on the San Dieguito Art Guild Website.

Show winners and entrants will be acknowledged and celebrated at the February 8th OffTrack Gallery Reception. Ribbons will be available when you pick up your art on February 24-25.

Pick up Work

Monday or Tuesday, February 24-25, 11am-6pm. Due to storage restrictions, any work not picked up by Feb 26th 6pm will be donated.

Description of Show Categories

Oil and Acrylic

Oil, acrylic, casein on canvas, masonite, or wood

Watercolor (Medium under Glass)

Any water medium on paper or illustration board which is framed under glass. Watercolor, casein, and gouache

Photography & Digital Art

Black & White, color, digital prints both manipulated and un-manipulated, and art that is created on the computer

Mixed Media

Two or more medias together, OR collage in more than one media

Other Media

- **Pastel.** Oil pastel or regular pastel
- **Drawings.** Conte, graphite, charcoal, pen & ink, marker, watercolor pencils or crayons, colored pencil.
- **3D-Wall Hanging.** Ceramic, glass, metal, wood, plastic, paper-mâché, bas-relief, or any other 3D piece. Must be wall hanging or framed.
- **Printmaking.** Must be original and not a series of prints. Linoleum or wood block, etching, or mono-prints. Collage (in one

media). If more than one media enter in Mixed Media.

- Encaustic
- Copper enameling

3-D Art: Must fit in 12"x12" display cube

- Free Standing (Wood, Sculpture, Ceramic, Glass, etc.)
- Textiles (Any product made of a textile material, purses, scarves, etc.)
- Jewelry (designed by artist)

Eligibility

- Open to all Southern California artists.
- All work must be **original work** of the artist and be for sale.
- No reproductions, copies or Giclées.

Sale of Art

15% commission will be collected on all work sold. The San Dieguito Art Guild collects sales tax from the buyer. Artists will be notified by phone upon the sale of their work.

Payment to the artist for sold pieces will arrive in the mail approximately one month following the sale.

Replacement of Sold Art

The artist may hang another piece of the same size to replace sold art.

Entry Rules

- Maximum entry size for 2D work is 47" as measured diagonally, including frame.
- 3-D work must fit in 12"x12" display cube.
- Works in paper must be under glass.
- Accepted artwork may not be removed until the end of the show unless sold.

- All work must be original and completed in the past 3 years.
- Art must be your own creation and must not use copyrighted source material unless you own the copyright.
- Art created as part of a classroom project, that was partially designed by an instructor, is prohibited.
- Work must be clean and dry.
- All 2D works must have a multi-strand wire attached securely using D-rings (NO saw-tooth hangers). The ends of the wire must be taped using blue painter's tape. Other hanging devices/methods will be rejected.
- You must securely attach art/artist identification on the back of your submissions.
- Work must be framed or gallery wrapped canvas of any depth. If gallery wrapped, *sides must be painted or otherwise finished* (no staples on the sides).
- Please review the full artwork preparation guidelines on our website.

- SDAG/OTG is not liable for damage or loss of artwork submitted into the show. It is suggested you insure your own work.
